  Using wire binding has removed the need for separate documents.
- 5. Introduction of "Implementation" sections to rationale. Done.
- foreword: Replace "Members of X3" with "200x Membership"
- 7. Addition of Change Log appendix

## Matters Arising

1. Proposals Process

PΚ

- (a) Modify the first paragraph of section (b) to include the following line:
  - Be warned, this will generate a lot of heated discussion.
- (b) Add the following to section (f):

If you can not attend a meeting, you should ask somebody who is attending to champion the proposal on your behalf.

2. Membership

Add a paragraph relating to how a person becomes a member of the committee. This paragraph is to go through the fast track RfD procedure.

3. Obsolescent features

Introduce a new "Obsolete Word set". Removing the words currently listed in section 1.4.2.

4. Inline text

The inline rationale should be rendered in a different font, such as sans-serif. PK The idea of separating the testing and/or reference implementations into separate appendices was discussed with no conclusive outcome.

5. RFI0007 AE/PK

Integrate RFI0007 (IMMEDIATE vs "compilation semantics") into the document.

6. Review all RFI documents for integration into the document:

RFI 0001: meaning of "flag" returned by READ-LINE at end of file.

RFI 0002: duplicate wordlist in the search order.

RFI 0003: What's allowed between CREATE and DOES>.

RFI 0004: Standard punctuation for double-cell numbers.

RFI 0005: Initiation semantics.

RFI 0006: Writing to Input Buffers.

RFI 0007: Distinction between IMMEDIATE and "special compilation semantics"

Introduction of a "review" meeting for detailed discussion of RfDs was discussed. Investigate the possibility of attaching this meeting to the Forth-Tagung in late April (24/5).
